**The Crypt on the Green, St James Clerkenwell,
Clerkenwell Close, London, EC1R 0EA**

Clerkenwell is an area of central London lying south of Kings Cross between the City and the West End. The Crypt on the Green lies directly beneath St James Church, in Clerkenwell Close overlooking Clerkenwell Green. Look for the distinctive white stone tower, visible in most directions from some way off.

The **nearest tube stations** are Farringdon (Circle / Hammersmith & City / Metropolitan Line) to the South, and Angel (Northern Line) to the North.

Street **parking** around the church is by meter.
Metered times are 8:30am-6:30pm Mon-Fri.
